

Just some comments to improve the manuscript:

1. **Clarify population context:**

Add one or two sentences in the *Introduction* specifying the **regional or demographic characteristics** of the studied cohort (e.g., ethnicity, healthcare setting). This helps readers understand how generalizable the modified STOP-Bang findings may be to other populations.

2. **Enhance the visual summary:**

Consider adding a **graphical abstract or flow diagram** illustrating patient selection, exclusion, and analysis steps. This would make the study design and sample flow easier to follow, especially for clinical readers.

3. **Refine key discussion paragraph:**

In the *Discussion*, slightly expand the paragraph explaining the **clinical implications** of using a lower STOP-Bang threshold—how it could affect screening efficiency or resource allocation in sleep clinics.

4. **Statistical clarity:**

When presenting ROC analysis results, specify **95% confidence intervals** for AUC values and sensitivity/specificity metrics. This would emphasize the robustness and reproducibility of the reported predictive performance.

5. **Consistency and style:**

Ensure uniform formatting across the manuscript—particularly for **percentages, p-values, and units** (e.g., write “ $p = 0.03$ ” consistently, not “ $p < 0.03$ ”), and define all abbreviations at first mention in both text and tables.
