- 1. The English is needed to improve. This manuscript requires major English language editing.
- 2. The survey method section should be extended, and all sites that used must be mentioned.
- 3. Conclusion is general; it should be a conclusion of their work, and the authors do not provide a discussion about how their findings connect with the study aims and how their work fits into the larger framework of the related literature.
- 4. The references related to one person must be ordered based on published year. For example, Li's publications have been mentioned 2012, 2015, 2013, 2018, 2018, 2017.
- 5. The published year of reference "Zhou et al." was mentioned 2015; but the correct one is 2016.
